HTML5 Package = **H5P**

- Open-source content collaboration framework based on JavaScript
- Intent: make it easy for everyone to create, share and reuse interactive HTML5 content such as interactive videos, quizzes, presentations, timelines etc.
- Four platform integrations exist: Drupal, WordPress, Tiki and Moodle.
- 2024 H5P Group was acquired by D2L (Canadian-based company that is behind Brightspace)





Drag and Drop







Game Map


Stages you create on top of a background image. Each state can hold content for user to view or complete. Define the rules for what stage the user is allowed to move to – gaming experience.





Multiple Hot Spots


Image based test – learner must find correct spots on an image.







The Baroque is a highly ornate and often extravagant style of architecture, art and music that flourished in Europe from the early 17th until the mid-18th century. It followed the Renaissance style and preceded the Rococo (in the past often referred to as "late Baroque") and Neoclassical styles. It was encouraged by the Catholic Church as a means to counter the simplicity and austerity of Protestant architecture, art and music, though Lutheran Baroque art developed in parts of Europe as well.

The Baroque style used contrast, movement, exuberant detail, deep colour, grandeur and surprise to achieve a sense of awe. The style began at the start of the 17th century in Rome, then spread rapidly to France, northern Italy, Spain and Portugal, then to Austria and southern Germany.





Allows users to add accessible and web enabled accordions to course content that is too much to put on one page or you want a cleaner display of just what is expanded.







Image Juxtaposition

Column

Allows users to add multiple-choice, fill in blanks and such along with text and illustrations in a columnar layout.



The Kon-Tiki expedition was a 1947 journey by raft across the Pacific Ocean from South America to the Polynesian islands, led by Norwegian explorer and writer Thor Heyerdahl. The raft was named Kon-Tiki after the Inca sun god, Viracocha, for whom "Kon-Tiki" was said to be an old name.

Heyerdahl believed that people from South America could have settled Polynesia in pre-Columbian times. His aim in mounting the Kon-Tiki expedition was to show, by using only the materials and technologies available to those people at the time, that there were no technical reasons to prevent them from having done so.
