- 5. If the name is different than the tool you're linking to, make sure it makes sense in the context of your course. For example, if you are using **Journals** for weekly reflections you could name a link to the Journal tool 'Weekly Reflections'

## **Reorder your Tool Link in the Course Menu**

11. Any new link you add will appear at the bottom of the menu.

You can change that by hovering over the link you created until a while box with an arrow appears.

Click the arrow and drag the link up (or down) to where you want it to appear.

This will work for all items in your Course Menu.

\*Note If you are unable to click and drag an item, Look for the up and down arrows at the top of the Course Menu. You can manually reorder menu items from there.
